Come, Lord Jesus, and Show Us the Father

Dear members of Shepherd of the Lake,

Advent means coming and coming means preparing. This Advent, during our midweek services at 6:00pm each Wednesday, the truth that will prepare us for Christ's coming is the First Article of the Apostle's Creed, "I believed in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth," as well as Luther's Small Catechism explanation of that article of faith. Our theme is that Jesus came, will come, and does come today by His Word and Spirit in order to show us who God is. Our goal is not only to learn the doctrine, that is, the teaching of the faith, but to learn the faith, that is, true trust in the Father who justifies us by grace through faith on account of Jesus Christ. Our prayer is that Christ would indeed come among us and show us the Father.

The first Advent midweek service on December 2 will prepare us for Christ with the truth that <u>Jesus shows us our Creator</u>. Luther says, "I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them" (SC, explanation of the First Article). Psalm 95.1–7 says, "Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods. In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker! For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand."

The second Advent midweek service on December 9 will prepare us for Christ with the truth that <u>Jesus shows us our Provider</u>. Luther says, "He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life" (SC, explanation of the First Article). Psalm 104.27–30 says, "*These all look to you, to give them their food in due season. When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are filled with good things. When you hide your face, they are dismayed; when you take away their breath, they die and return to their dust. When you send forth your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground."*

The third Advent midweek service on December 16 will prepare us for Christ with the truth that <u>Jesus shows us the Father's heart</u>. Luther says, "He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him" (SC, explanation of the First Article). Psalm 103.11–13 says, "For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. As a father shows compassion to his children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him."

May God send His Spirit among us this Advent that through the truth that Jesus shows us the Father, we may be ready to receive Him when He comes again.

Dear Shepherd of the Lake members,

After worship this past Sunday, Gaylord Ryg gave the following report regarding our assisted living project in partnership with Good Shepherd Community:

"The people of Good Shepherd have decided against building an assisted living facility in Garrison, Minn. The primary reason was the unexpected announcement that the Aitkin Armory will be converted into forty-one assisted living units. To use their words, "that was a game changer." There was also concern about finding staff workers, given the conditions of the local economy. They also expressed reservations about what they perceived as a lack of commitment by the congregation to the project."

BUTTERMILK COOKIES

From the kitchen of: *Memory of Ollie Thaemert*

3 c. Sugar 2 tsp. Soda

2c. Shortening ½ tsp. Nutmeg 2 Eggs 1 tsp. Baking Powder

1 tsp. Vanilla 4 c. Flour

2. Buttermilk Enough Flour to Roll

Mix shortening, sugar, and eggs, beat together. Add vanilla. Mix buttermilk and soda, and add to mixture. Sift nutmeg, baking powder and flour and add to mixture. Roll out and cut cookies. Bake in quick oven at 410° for approximately 10 minutes. Decorate as desired.



MINCEMEAT APPLE BETTY From the kitchen of: unknown

 $1\ {}^3\!\!/_4$ C. Prepared Mincemeat

½ tsp. grated Lemon Peel

4 c. pared and sliced Apples

½ c. Brown Sugar

½ c. Flour

1 tsp. Cinnamon

¼ c. Butter

Combine mincemeat and lemon peel; place half the apples in bottom of greased 10X6X2 inch pan. Cover with half of the mincemeat. Repeat layers. Combine remaining ingredients and sprinkle over top. Bake in a 350° oven until apples are tender, about 45 minutes. Serve warm with cream.
