This year we plan to run VBS from June 12-16 in the morning at Shepherd of the Lake. In this 500th anniversary year of the Lutheran Reformation we will be using the theme, "Mighty Fortress...In Jesus the Victory is Won!" This is based on the Bible verse, "Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (1 Corinthians 15:57)

PEACH DUMP CAKE

From the kitchen of: Jean Stokes

1 Yellow Cake Mix

1 c. Vegetable Oil

4 large Eggs

13.5 oz. package Instant Vanilla Pudding

1 c. Water

1 26oz. can sliced Peaches, drained, Reserving 3 Tbsp. of the Syrup

8 oz. Cream Cheese, softened

1 c. Granulated Sugar

Preheat oven to 350° F. Spray at 9X13 baking dish with cooking spray. Beat cake mix, oil, eggs, pudding mix and water with an electric mixer until smooth. Pour into prepared pan. Layer peaches on top of batter.

Beat cream cheese, sugar and 3 Tbsp. of the reserved peach syrup with an electric mixer until smooth. Spread over peaches. Bake 50-60 minutes.




