New Life in a New Year

My three-and a half year old grandson has an unusual interest in calendars: he finds and marks the birthdays of family members; notices how the numbers match up with days of the week along with any noticeable patterns; and keeps us all prepared for the next week and month of our lives. So, we share with him any calendars that come our way.

The arrival of a new year, 2018, gives us all a new perspective on our lives. Many will make personal and family resolutions in the attempt to improve their situation, whatever it might be. To be able to leave certain things behind and to move forward without looking back is both a challenge and an opportunity, as the apostle Paul says "But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead...." (Phil.3:13).

What we can celebrate as God's people is that we have been given new life through our baptism into the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. In this Epiphany season we see that Jesus himself submitted to the waters of Baptism by John, and in so doing brings divine power and eternal meaning to our Baptism. 'Fleshly birth is one thing, but heavenly birth is another,' as Jesus tells Nicodemus and us.

Jesus in comparison with John the Baptizer is the One who will baptize "with the Holy Spirit and fire." In Christ Jesus we have been given new and eternal life, and are now able to shake off the old, put it to death and leave it behind, much like a snake shedding its skin and leaving it behind.

More important than a new year (calendar wise) is the new life in Christ which joins us to the eternal and the Eternal One. It is Iesus the Risen and Living One who says and does it "Behold, I make all things new." (Rev. 21:5).

May this new calendar year be filled with opportunities to grow and mature in our new life in Christ: to worship the LORD with new fervor; to serve Him with new zeal: to care for one another with a new commitment of Christ-like love; and to reach out in new ways with the truth and compassion of Christ.

Yes, together we will fill the calendar of 2018 in a new way.
